CUT TO WIFE STILL WATCHING HUSBAND, EYES WIDE, LOOKING EXCITED BUT ANXIOUS.

WIFE (VO): (ANXIOUSLY) Another Sunday, another game...

CUT TO HUSBAND LOOKING UNAMUSED, SITTING BACK ON COUCH, ONE ARM RESTING ON THE ARM OF THE COUCH, HOLDING LA CROIX.

HUSBAND: (AGITATED) I can't believe thi-

SUDDENLY HE JERKS UPRIGHT, LEANING IN TOWARDS THE TV, EYES WIDENING.

**HUSBAND:** (WITH NEWFOUND EXCITEMENT) Oh! Oh, oh, oh!

CUT TO SHOT OF BOTH THE HUSBAND AND WIFE, HUSBAND STARTS RISING FROM HIS SEAT SLOWLY WHILE THE WIFE CONTINUES TO WATCH HIM INTENTLY FROM HER SEAT.

HUSBAND DEFEATEDLY LIFTS HIS CAN OF LA CROIX TO TAKE A SIP. AS SOON AS IT TOUCHES HIS LIPS, HIS WIFE JUMPS OFF THE COUCH FERVEROUSLY AND STARTS TO CHEER WILDLY.
